

## SOME TIPS :

- IF YOUR ARMS HAVE A PERIPHERAL CHARGE, SUCH AS A BORDURE OR AN ORLE, DRAW IT FIRST, IT'LL MAKE IT EASIER TO FIT THE OTHER CHARGES.
- IF YOU'VE GOT METAL CHARGES ON A DARK FIELD, DRAW THEM A TAD LARGER THAN USUAL. LIGHT-ON-DARK IS VISUALLY SMALLER THAN DARK-ON-LIGHT, EVEN WHEN THE DIMENSIONS ARE IDENTICAL.
- REMEMBER, BALANCE and FILLING THE SPACE ARE KEY.
